

EMU POINT TO ELLEN COVE & PORT ALBANY

DESCRIPTION

This is a versatile walk with many possible options and can be done in either direction.

If planning to start from Emu Point, to get to the start point from the Town Square travel up York Street and bear right at the top roundabout and left at the next roundabout into Middleton Road.

Turn left at a roundabout into Golf Links Road. Travel along Golf Links Road to Emu Point. Park either on Mermaid Avenue or Cunningham Street.

The walk commences from the café.



Grade: Two (2)

Distance: 8km one-way **Quality of Path:** Well formed track

Signs: Clearly sign posted

Experience: No experience required

Time: 2.5 to 3 hours

Steps: None

WALK NOTES

- Starting from the path in front of Emu Beach Café follow the path to the right and cross Cunningham Street and walk to the right with the Emu Point channel to your left.
- There is further parking and public toilets at Firth Street.
- 3. The good bitumen undulating path meanders alongside Middleton Beach through peppermint trees.
- 4. There are several lookouts and seats along the path to view the beach with the golf course on your right.
- 5. The path continues through Surfers Beach car park and passes alongside the Middleton Beach caravan park.
- 6. Continue along the beach front until you reach the café and playground at Ellen Cove.
- 7. To continue on to Albany follow the bitumen path and boardwalk uphill and around the edge of the rocky headland.
- 8. After approximately 900m there are steps to a lookout and a car park
- 9. There are several sidetracks to the rocks and up to Marine Drive.
- 10. After walking 2.5km from Ellen Cove you reach the end of the main dual use path. Vehicle access here is via Princess Royal Drive through the Port.
- 11. From this point the dual path now runs along Brunswick Road West for a further 2km to the City centre with views of the port silos and fuel depots on your left.
